*Approved the two-year agreement renewal with In-Shore Technology, in the amount of \$65,250 year one and \$66,000 for year two, as presented.

*Approved the agreement with Hollidaysburg School District to provide Alternative Education Services at a cost of \$18,200 per seat for the 2025-26 school year, pending review and approval of the agreement with Nittany Health.

*Adopted the IU8 Budget \$6,248,705, be adopted, with Williamsburg's share being \$1,368.17 (of the \$173,000 general budget), based on enrollment and aid ratio.

*Approved the Dual Credit Agreement with Penn State University, as presented.
