IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Prior to your child entering school, you must show proof that your child has received the following vaccines:

- **Diphtheria/Tetanus, and acellular pertussis** (DTP, Dtap) four or more properly spaced doses. One dose on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- **Polio-** four doses (4<sup>th</sup> dose on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and at least 6 months after previous dose given) A 4<sup>th</sup> dose is not necessary if the third dose was give at age 4 years or older and at least 6 months after the previous dose.
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) two doses.
- Hepatitis B vaccine three properly spaced doses.

**Elementary Principal** 

- **Varivax Immunity** (chicken pox) 2 doses of the vaccine or proof of history of having the disease.
- Children attending 7<sup>th</sup> grade need the following:
  - 1 dose of tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap). If 5 years has elapsed since the last tetanus immunization.
  - 1 dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV)
- Students attending 12<sup>th</sup> grade need the following:
  - 1 dose of MCV before or on the first day of 12<sup>th</sup> grade. If one dose was given at 16 years of age or older, that shall count as the 12 grade dose.

Proof of immunizations consists of written record from your physician showing dates (month, day and year) your child was immunized.
